



UNION *of* NATIONAL EMPLOYEES HUMAN RIGHTS AWARD

PURPOSE

Our human rights awards acknowledge outstanding achievement and exemplary conduct in promoting human rights.

CRITERIA

1. Nominees must be current or former UNE members belonging to one of our defined equity-seeking groups, women or allies.
2. Nominations may be made by a local executive, the National Executive or the human rights committee.
3. Nominations must be submitted using the attached application form and submitted to the UNE no later than June 30th.
4. All nominations for a human rights award must be reviewed by the human rights committee, which will send its recommendations to the National Executive.
5. No person may receive more than one award.

PROCESS

1. All decisions on the distribution of human rights awards are made after a two-thirds majority vote, by secret ballot, at the National Executive meeting before the human rights conference.
2. After the awards are presented, a photo and a brief summary will be published on our website and will be provided to the Public Service Alliance of Canada for publication.

AWARD

The award consists of a suitably framed certificate.

PRESENTATION

The awards are to be presented by the national president (or his or her designee) every three years at the human rights conference.
